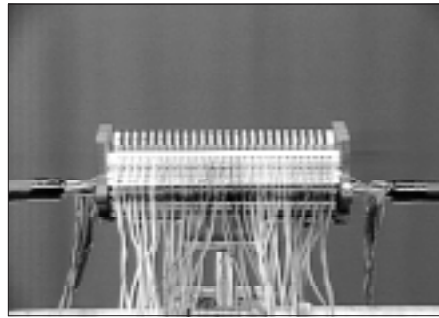

4036 Hand/Hydraulic Crimper

General

The 4036 Hand/Hydraulic Crimper is a self contained, pistol gripped, crimper designed to crimp MS²™ 4000 and 4005 Series splicing modules.



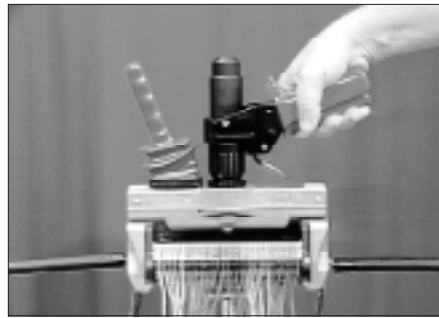
1. Prepare cable, splice head, and module using standard practice.



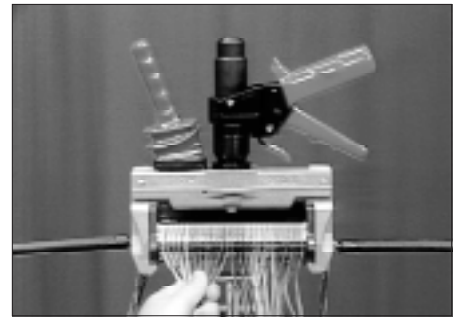
2. Locate hand tool on splice head.



3. Advance press-bar to module using hand lever.



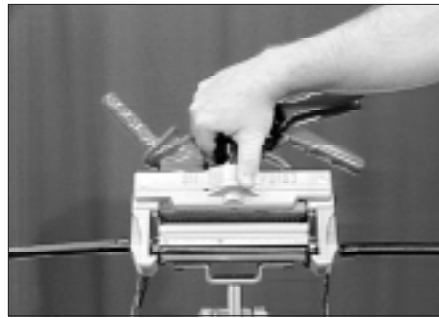
4. Pump handle until module is crimped and pressure by-pass operates.



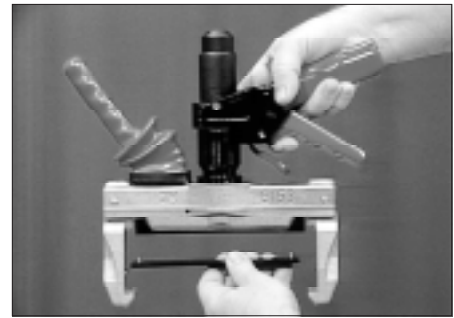
5. Remove excess wire from module by lifting groups of conductors straight up from retainer spring and pulling gently.



6. Retract press-bar by pulling release trigger.



7. Remove hand tool.



8. The hand tool is provided with a removable extension press-bar. When any module combinations are spliced (e.g. 4000D + 4005DPM), the extension must be removed by pulling directly from press-bar.

Note: *It is recommended to periodically clean the tool and treat all black coated steel parts with a protective oil film.*
